

A report on Tomáš Peprníček, the author of thesis:

INORGANIC FILLER IN POLYMER ENVIRONMENT

Mr. Tomáš Peprníček received his Ing. degree at Tomas Bata University in Zlin, Faculty of Technology, Dept. of Technology of Leather, Plastic and Rubber, Zlin in the year 2002, and after that he continued Ph.D. study at the Dept. of Polymer Engineering, Tomas Bata University in Zlin, Faculty of Technology. From 2005 he started his professional career at Tomas Bata University in Zlin and followed his Ph.D. study in an external form.

His Ph.D. work has been focused on the phenomena related to the nanocomposites of polymer / clay type system, dealing with study of PVC and PP compositions. The thesis itself contains a theoretical back-round of the topic and four papers – one already published, two accepted for publication and one submitted for publication in journals dealing with the research area.

During his studies Mr. Peprníček showed very broad theoretical knowledge of the problem and related areas, and worked purposively and independently with great effort and carefulness. He participated on research projects of the Faculty of Technology and published results on international meetings.

To conclude, it is my pleasure to recommend Mr. Tomáš Peprníček for the defense of his Ph.D. thesis.
